In addition to being physically challenged, Hansen’s disease patients have had to endure discrimination and prejudice as the result of societal indifference and ignorance about the disease.



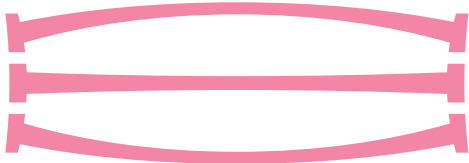
Sadness
